Retinal photography is a non-invasive procedure used to capture an image of the back part (retina) of your eye. I Care Optical uses retinal photos to document patients’ retinal conditions and provide baseline data that can be used to follow your health in subsequent years.

This test is highly recommended for all of our patients, especially those with a history of: diabetes, high blood pressure, glaucoma, headaches, floaters or flashing lights, and/or retinal problems.

In most cases, dilation is not needed; however, if you have diabetes, high blood pressure, or other diseases, the doctor will recommend dilation to get the best photo of your eyes.

**Some insurance companies will cover the expense of retinal photography as part of a routine eye exam. If this procedure is not covered by your insurance carrier, the discounted fee for this additional part of your eye exam is \$29.00 for both eyes. You are responsible for this service fee at the time of service.**
